#### **Action Plan**

## Focus of Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign -

- Empower communities through large scale awareness generation on water sanitation & hygiene, its impact on health and involving communities in planning and implementation of the campaign
- Build its institutional capacity by training healthcare provider/frontline workers like ANMS,
   ASHSs including VHSNC members

A. Preparatory Activities:

1.	11-14 September 2018	State/District /Block to initiate preparatory action for conducting the "Swachtaa Hi Seva" campaign.	
2.	13 September 2018	District level Planning and coordination meeting between Health Dept. and Swachh Bharat Mission and further communication to public Health Facilities – SCs, PHC, CHCs, SDHs, DHs, UPHCs, UCHCs and other public health facilities.	
3.	14 September 2018	Planning and coordination meeting at Public Health Facilities level and VHSNCs/MAS level Planning	
4.	11-14 September 2018	Districts can prepare IEC on "Swachhata Hi Seva 2018", IEC to create awareness on Water Sanitation & Hygiene and thei impact on Health and its dissemination till village level.	

# PLANNING ACTIVITIES FOR COMMUNITY LEVEL ACTION:

# 1. Planning at district level for the campaign

District teams to meet Block Community Mobilizer and ASHA Facilitators and draw up a
plan for ASHA in every Gram Panchayat/ Urban local body area to undertake cleanliness
activities in the community in collaboration with Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition
Committee (VHSNC) and Mahila Arogya Samiti (MAS).

## 2. Planning at the village/slum level for the campaign

 Planning in the community for the campaign by conducting meeting of ASHA and members of VHSNC and MAS.

- Transect walk in the community to identify the common area which are in need of cleanliness. A social and resource map to be prepared to identify the hamlets in need of cleanliness activities in a participatory manner.
- Volunteers may be identified from every pocket of the community.
- ASHA to work with VHSNC and Sub-centre staff to mobilize volunteers and government staff to participate in the two week long campaign.
- All materials required for village cleaning would be arranged in advance.

# B. Timeline of "Swachhata Hi Seva 2018" Campaign 15th September to 2nd October 2018

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1.	Swachharambh- Nationwide Launch of Campaign with Collective Swachhata Pledge at 11 AM on 15 September 2018 by Doctors/Staff, in respective facilities and at the village level involving ASHAs, local leaders and NGOs, Voluntary Organizations followed by statewide Shramdaan.	
2.	Rollout of two weeks long Campaign in Public Health Facilities and at the village level. (Details of suggested activities and Guidance Plan at Annexure )	to
3.	Swachhata Sabhas in Gram Panchayat involving VHSNC members	2 <sup>nd</sup> October 2018  16th September 2018
4.	Participation in Seva Diwas activities organized by Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation	
5.	Daily uploading of activities/ photos/ HD Videos of	15th September to 2nd October 2018

Celebration of 2nd October as "Swachhata hai Swasth Jeevan Ki Buniyad" through activities such as, competition for children/poster exhibition on sanitation and hygiene options, public recognition of the volunteers/staff/VHSNC that participated in the activity

### Swachhtaa Hi Seva, 2018

- All Public health facilities across the states (District Hospitals, Community Health Centres, Primary health Centres and Sub Centres), should organize 'Swachhta Drive' to build awareness on sanitation and cleanliness and initiate change in practices.
- The period of 11 to 14th September, 2018 should be used for the overall planning and preparations of the campaign.
- The two week long Swachhtaa Hi Seva, 2018 campaign from 15th September, 2018 to 2nd October, 2018 to be flagged off with a Collective 'Swachhata Pledge' to be taken by all Doctors and staff of public health facilities, ASHAs, VHSNC Members involving local leaders, NGOs, Voluntary organizations on 15th September, 2018 at 11 AM.
- States /UTs may refer guidance note of VISHWAS' (Village based Initiative to Synergise Health, Water and Sanitation) - VHSNC Campaign Initiative for Swachhua and Swasthya for carrying out various activities during "Swachhata Hi Seva 2018 Campaign at village level.
- The focus of the campaign is empowering communities and building capacity of health care providers.
- · The suggested activities are as under:
  - o Open Defecation Free (ODF) Village Day- efforts should be given on behaviour change for using toilets and to make villages ODF.
  - o Hand Washing Day- Hand-washing demonstration in Anganwadis, schools and in communities during gram Sabhas and imparting its importance.
  - O Hold Swachhta camps, Swachhata rallies Poster /Rangoli/essay writing Competitions, Nukkad Natak, Watt Painting, Video making Competition on Swachh Bharat and create awareness, Out of Box challenges related to Swachhtaa and its impact on health.
  - o Organize cleanliness drives in and around the public health facilities by doctors and staff of facilities including ASHAs.
  - o Sanitation day in communities, Public places like School and Anganwadi, Shramdhan in the community/schools. Involving local NGOs, Voluntary Organisations, Youth organizations and Self help Groups for Shramadan.
  - o Liquid and Solid Waste Management Day- creating awareness on liquid and solid waste and its proper disposal.
  - No plastic drive- awareness sessions on the detrimental effects of reckless use of plastic and on its scientific disposal should be organized at educational institutions. Drives to collect plastic waste and litter in tourist places, parks, benches, public gathering places, bus stands etc. should be taken up.
  - Organise public talk on various topics like water, sanitation and hygiene and its importance, hazardous effect of pollution and measure to reduce it, talk on various communicable diseases air and water born diseases, vector born diseases etc., importance of personal oral hygiene,
  - Talk on menstrual hygiene and disposal of sanitary napkins for adolescent girls in schools & colleges.

- o Health Awareness Day / Healthy Life Style Day.
- Vector Control Day-creating awareness among communities.
- o Tree Plantation drive
- o Implementation of 5 S methodologies at work places, better work place environment, green work place initiative etc.

## Capacity Building:

- Training of the staff including sweepers/MPWS/ASHAs wherever applicable on the under-mentioned topics may be carried out during the drive:
  - o 5-'S' methodology

o Hand-washing techniques

e Segregation of waste Handling and treatment of biomedical waste

o Methods of Cleaning of special areas - OT, Labour Room, Nursery ACU.

o Disinfection and Sterilization methods, Management in CSSD department.

o Training of regular Aseptic techniques such as IM drug administrations, suturing, dressing of wounds, surgical sits infection care, labour room practices, preparation of OT etc. (Resource

o Training on management of spill - Body Fluid, Chemical, mercury etc.

### Empowering Community

- · Active participation of community, particularly at Health Sob Centre level and larger community involvement should be ensured in the process of conducting cleanliness drive, and people as well as charity organizations should be encouraged to contribute their resources to this drive. People should also be encouraged to volunteer for Shramdaan. Role of ASHA is crucial for initiating activities at community level.
- During the period of 15 to 24 September, a special meeting of ASHAs, on Sanitation and Hygiene, should be organized at the block or PHC level, in all states, in this meeting a week long village level campaign on sanitation and hygiene should be planned, which each ASHA will facilitate in her area in collaboration with the VHSNC of the village.
- · Collective action involving the whole village/slam community for cleaning the selected common areas and other areas like school. Anganwadi, Panchayat Bhavan or any other place.
- · Day 14th
  - o A talk on the importance of cleanliness by members of the community which can be followed by a brief discussion on the resources available in the community as well as challenges they came across during the campaign.
  - o The week long campaign will undertake a villege level trive focusing on - general cleanliness of the village and Individual Hygiene, building and use of tollets, School and Anganwadi sanitation, Liquid and Solid Wasto Management, Pronvotion of hand-washing, cleanliness for vector control,

and Promotion of Healthy Life-style. Community level discussions and activities focused on each of these themes can be taken up on different days of the campaign. Focus should be given to Reinforce "Sanitation as Everyone's Business" and to Re-energize the Swachh Bharat Jan Andolan.

- On 2 October, 2018, Gandhi Jayanti could be celebrated in the facilities and village level on the theme of 'Swachhata hai Swasth Jeevan Ki Buniyad' through activities such as, Competition for children/poster exhibition on Sanitation and Hygiene options, Public recognition of the volunteers/ staff /VHSNC that participated in the activity.
- Programme teams and agencies working under Swachh Bharat Mission (both SBM-rural and SBM-urban) could be co-opted for activities at every level as well as Gram Panchayats / villages particularly for WASH training etc Coordination mechanisms may be put in place by states.
- The expenses for Swachhtaa Hi Seva may be met out of IEC funds/untied grants of facilities and VHSNC funds under NHM.
- States may also tap CSR funds for the activities

### IEC Planning (focus on behaviour change);

- Use of social media like Twitter, Face Book, State specific NHM websites on daily basis through use of infographics to highlight swachhtaa activities undertaken during Swachhtaa Hi Seva Campaign, State
- Screening of a video / movie show on the theme of Sanitation and Hygiene (eg: Toilet Ek Prem Katha, Pad Man and other such movies and videos).
